If you are signed up for Home Banking and you mail us a deposit or loan payment, we will no longer mail your receipt. You can look on Home Banking and see the transaction.

Watch for 1099's. They will be mailed out in January.

Tips to help defend you against thieves!

1. Avoid throwing away any private documentation - bills, credit card offers, bank statements - that contains personal identifying details without first running it through a paper shredder.
2. Take receipts after a purchase and check their listed amounts against credit card bills.
3. People should avoid carrying their Social Security cards and should not share their nine-digit numbers with anyone unless they've properly verified the person or company.
4. Individuals who plan to take a vacation should ask to have their mail delivery temporarily suspended.
5. Use a different password for each online account and use a combination of numbers, capital letters, and, if possible, symbols.
